Dear Parent/Guardian,

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all students and their families a happy and safe summer holiday.

Please find enclosed a copy of your son's Summer Report. (Junior Cert students will receive their results in September). Take time to discuss the results with your son, encourage and praise good results and set about making a plan to address areas where they might need to work harder next year.

If you would like to make an appointment to see me about any concerns you have, I will be available in the school after the August Bank Holiday weekend.

I would be grateful if you would note the following few points and discuss with your son before the school reopens in August :

Uniform

- Please note that as specified in the Code of Conduct **shoes and not runners** are the only acceptable footwear. **Black runners will not be permitted.**
- **Facial piercings and earrings are not allowed.** Students will not be allowed into class if wearing such jewellery
- **Hoodies are not allowed.** Students should preferably wear the school coat available from suppliers (County Seat and Classic Casuals) or another black anorak at all times.

Behaviour

- We set very high expectations in regard to good behaviour in the College. This leads to a good atmosphere conducive to teaching

and learning, and to positive relationships where each student has the right to attend school and feel happy and safe.

- Students involved in bullying others in any way in school or outside school will be severely dealt with.
- Any student who is found with fireworks will be immediately removed from the school and in keeping with school policy the Garda will be informed.
- Students involved in fighting or who physically abuse others in the school, outside the school grounds, or downtown will be removed from the school and dealt with by the Board of Management. Such behaviour brings the good name of the school and the good name of the majority of students into disrepute.

Attitude to homework and study

- Students should use the school journal to organise their study and homework. This has been shown to be the most effective way to succeed in school. Students should record homework for each subject everyday and consult the Journal each evening to track progress and to prepare for the following day.
- Parents/guardians should look at the Journal regularly and talk to their son about their school work. Time spend doing this will pay dividends in the longterm.

The school reopens for 3rd and 6th year students on Monday 29th August, 2nd and 5th on Tuesday 30th August, and all others on Wednesday 31st August. A full calendar for the year is enclosed.

Again, I hope you have a pleasant summer holiday and we look forward to seeing you in August.
